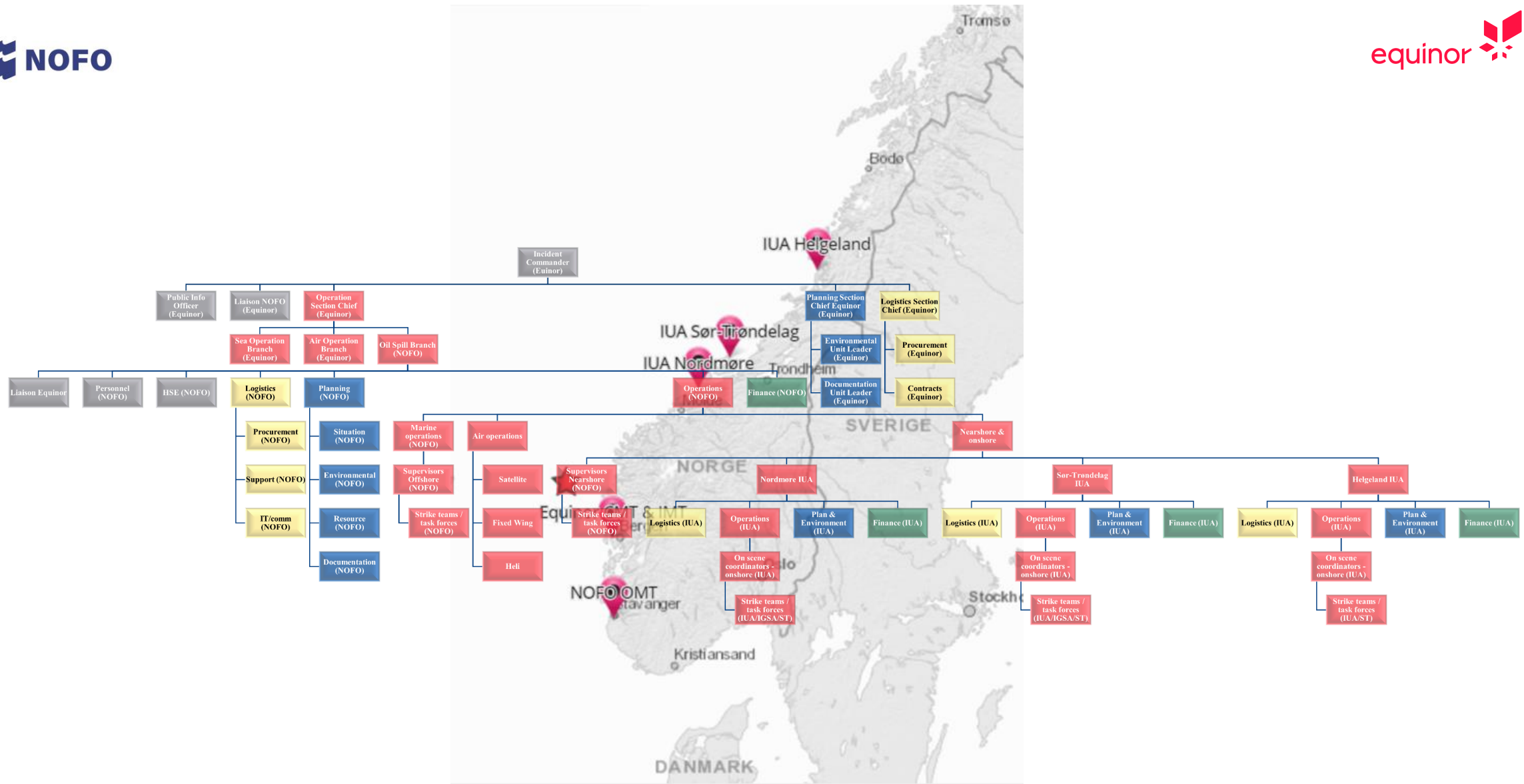
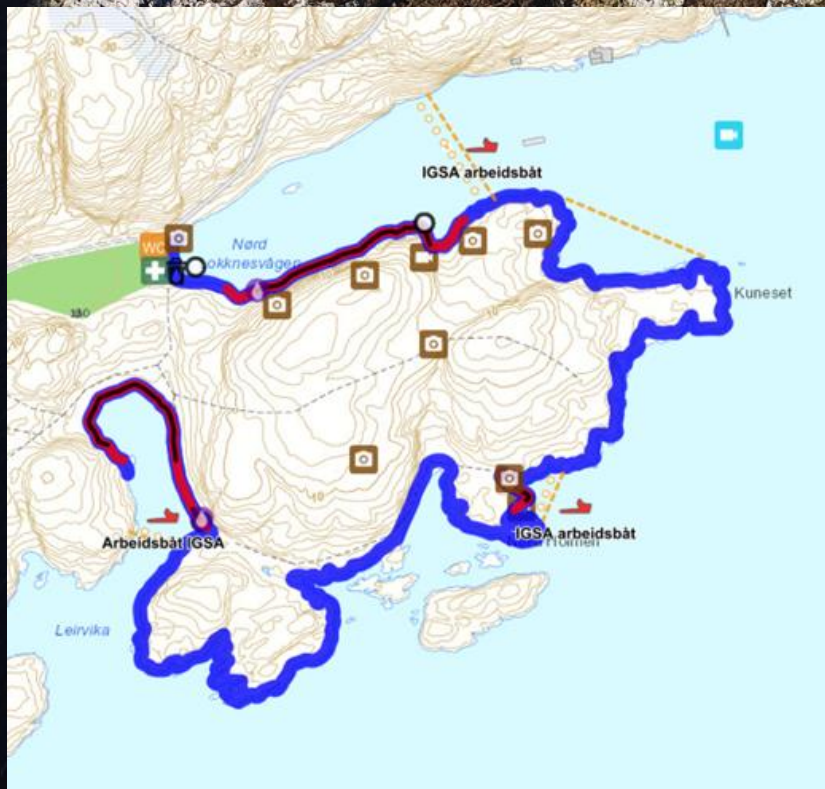


Figure 5 Incident Management Team at all locations - Exercise Frohavet 2019

Evaluation and lessons learned



- Highly resource demanding
- NOFO COP OSR is a valuable tool for common situational awareness
- Meeting structure and communication lines towards the field supervisors need to improve
 - The need of better tools for reporting key numbers and critical information
- Communication lines and equipment between different response groups in the field needs to improve.
- A common platform for sharing incident documents
