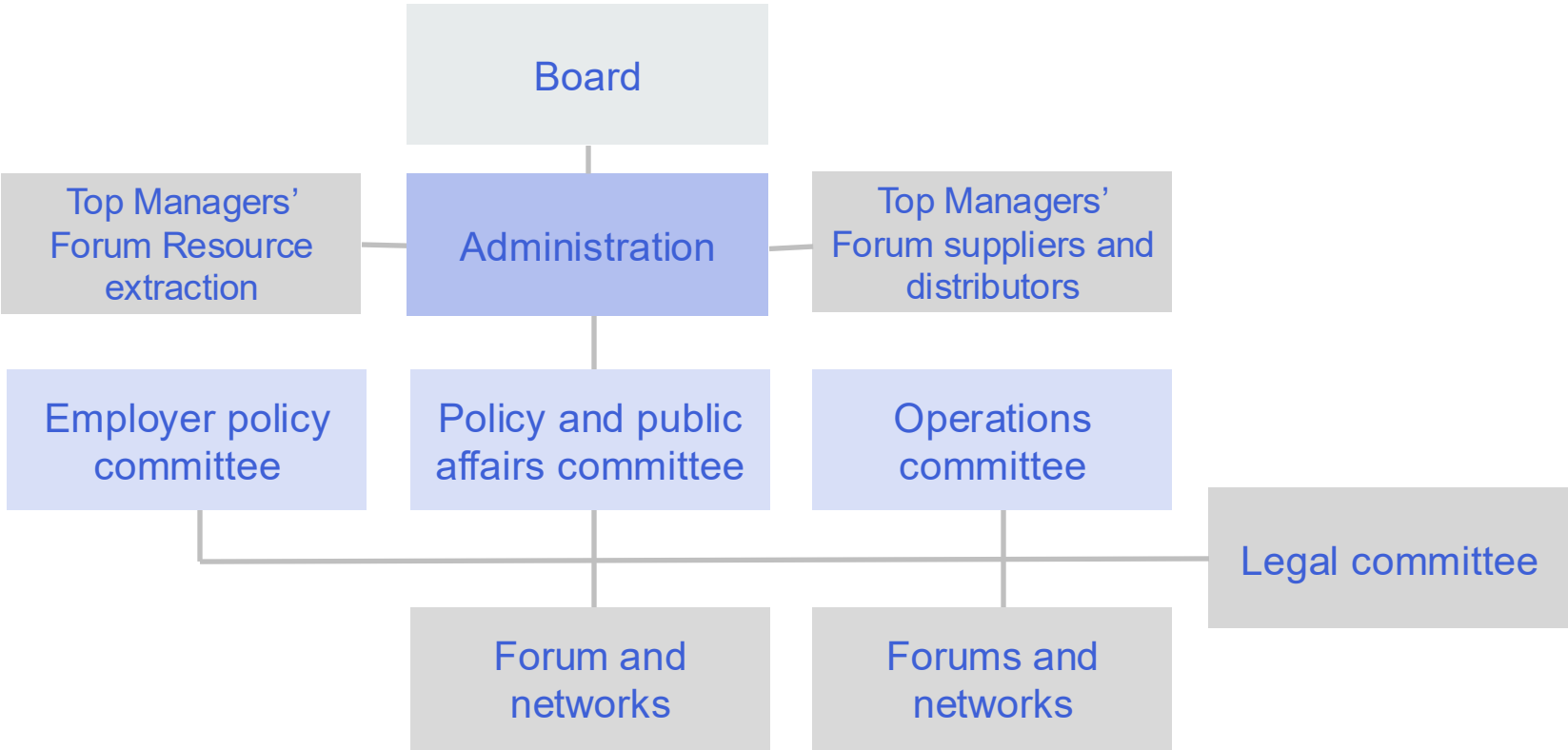
We fulfil a range of roles:

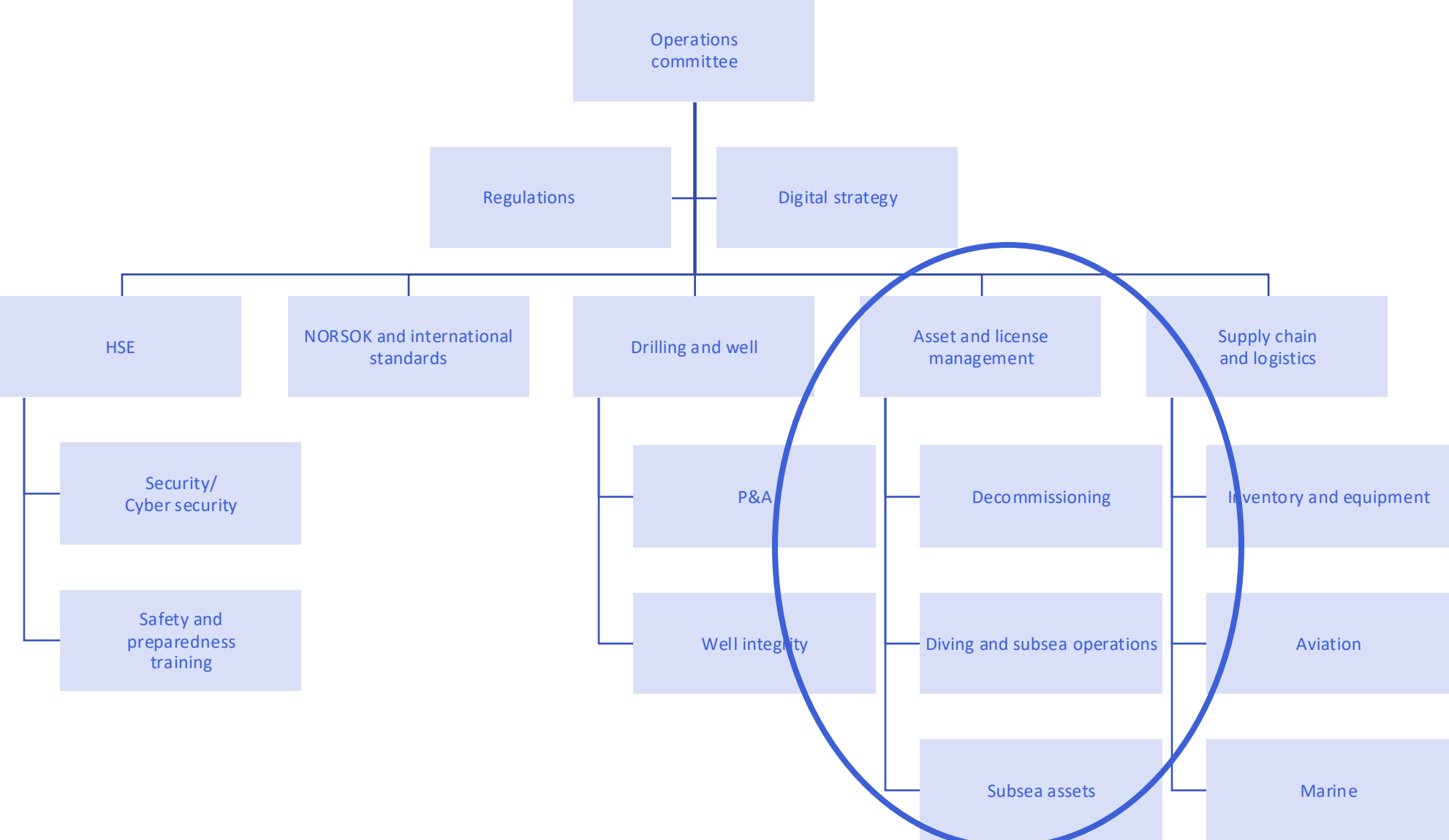

# ASSET AND LICENSE MANAGEMENT FORUM



## PURPOSE

- The forum is established by and provides advice to the Director General of Offshore Norge.
- Operations committee is parent to the forum.
- The Asset and license management forum will contribute actively to meeting Offshore Norge's strategic goals (the applicable strategy at any given time) within the mandate's area of responsibility.

## AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY

The Asset and license management forum will follow up matters within the following areas:

- Asset and license management
- Facility operations
- Decommissioning
- Diving and subsea operations
- Subsea assets

Decommissioning, Diving and subsea operations and Subsea assets each have their own dedicated network which will give recommendations to the forum.

## VALUE

The Asset and license management forum **shall actively pursue value creation with special emphasis on “more effective field and license collaboration** (learnings, optimisation and data), including operations-related challenges and cooperation on facility operations, production and decommissioning”.

## TASKS

The Asset and license management forum **will contribute to** the following:

- **Exchange experience and best practices**
- Give input to hearings to new relevant regulations and amendments to existing regulations
- Engage in evaluation and revision of relevant guidelines
- Give input to and prioritise relevant budget items
- Advice and follow up of existing and new industry collaboration projects
- **Support and actively pursue standardisation and data sharing**
- Actively further enhance and improve existing and possible new tools within the digital collaboration portfolio that supports asset and license management as a business area
- Advise strategically prioritised areas and goals related to license and field collaboration
- **Common understanding of and active compliance** with the joint operating agreement
- Assessment and handling of business cases and possible advances in defined processes and priority areas

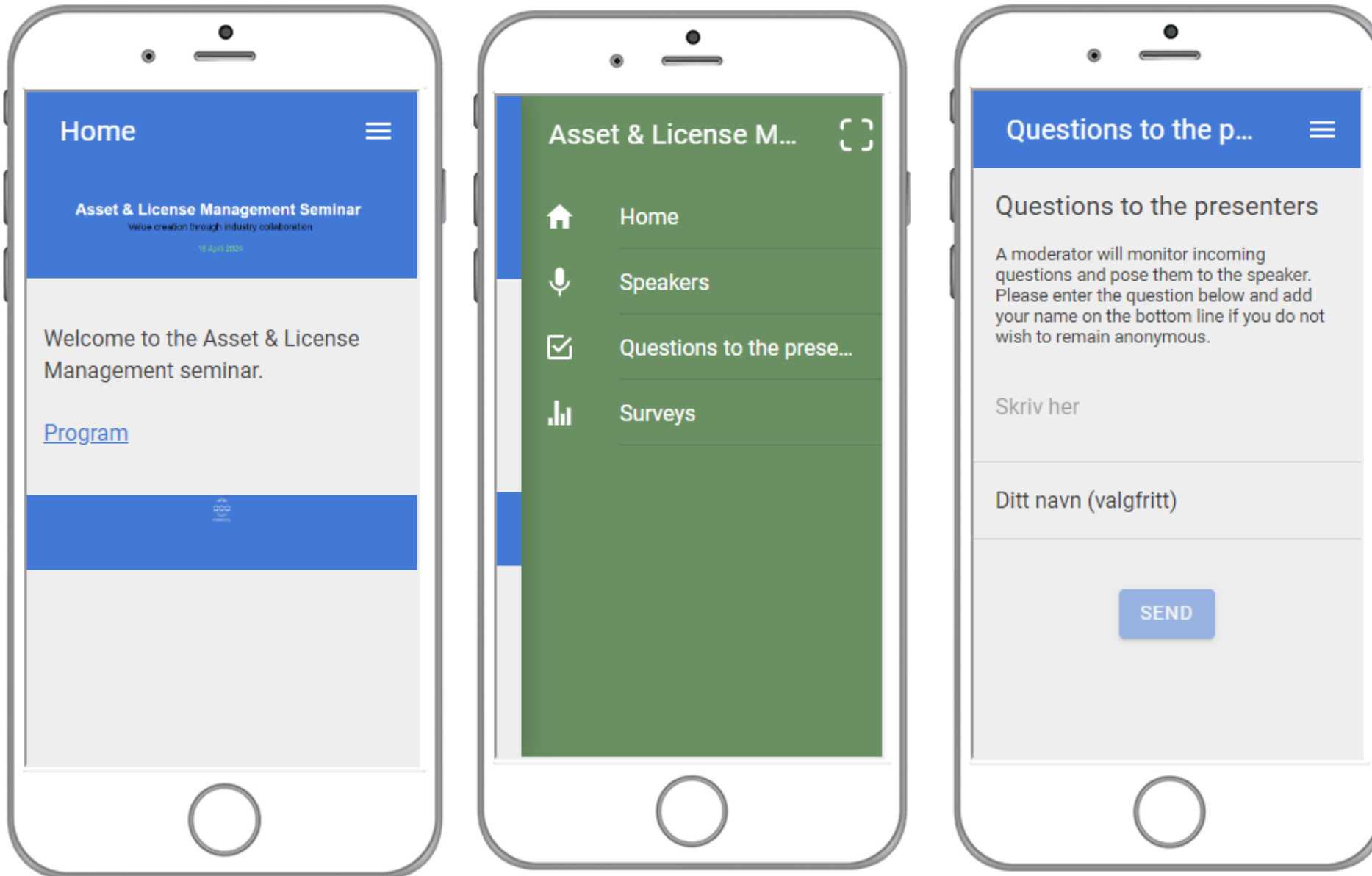
