

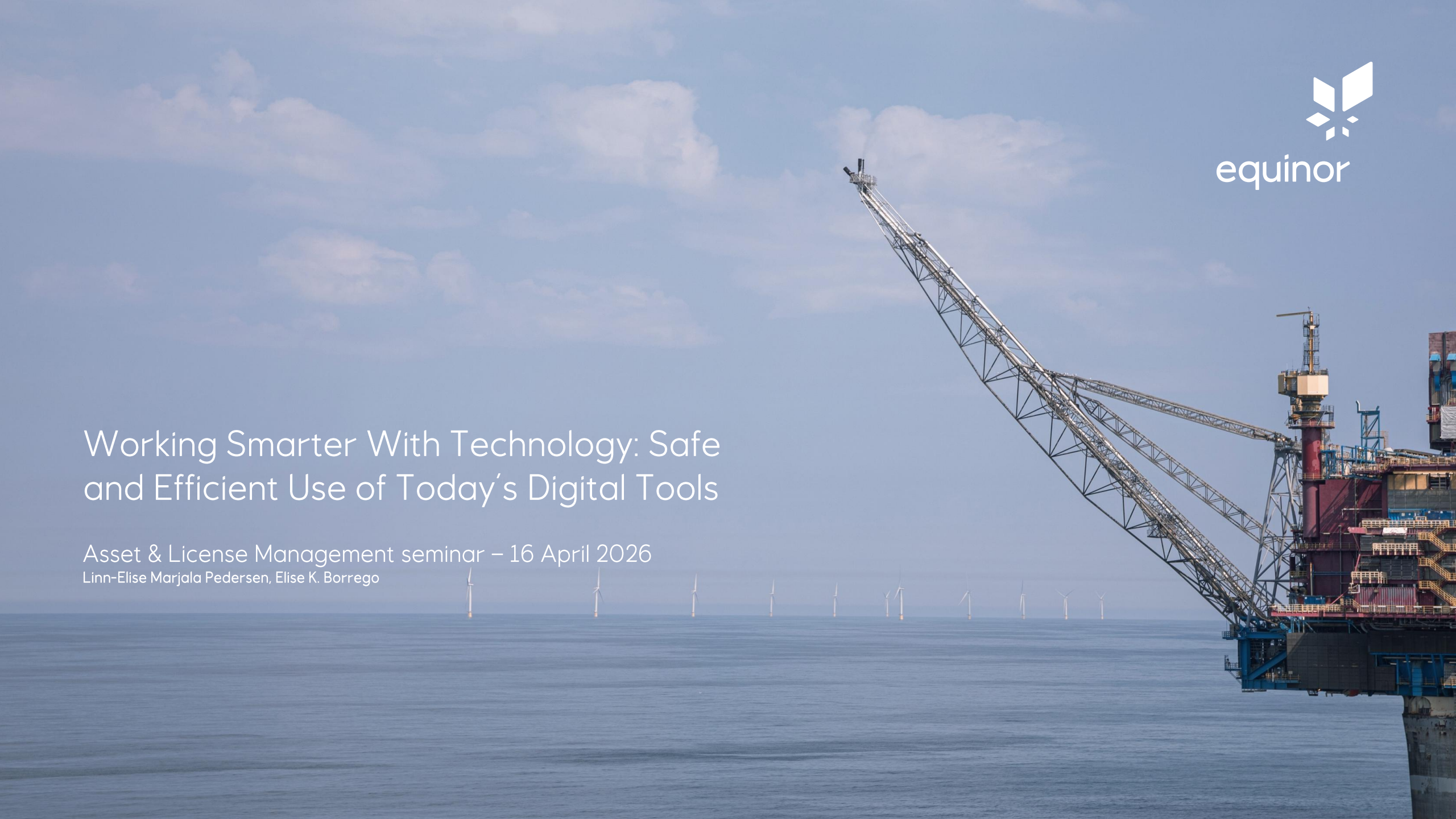

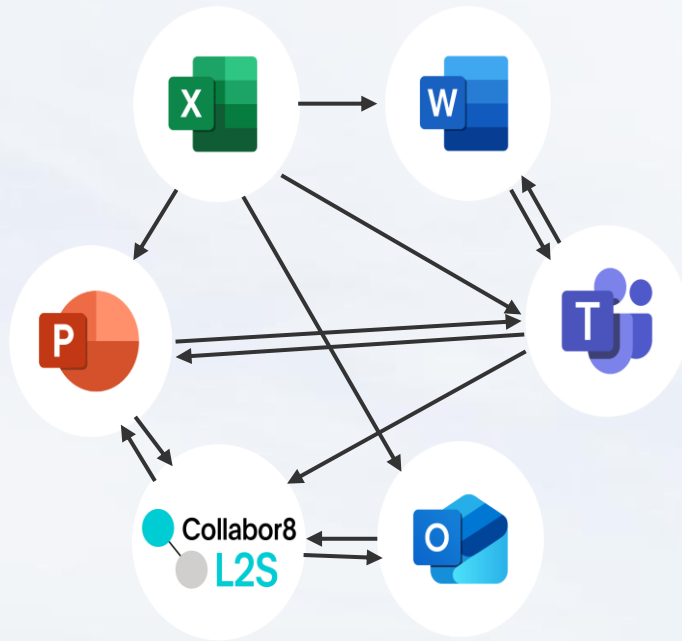

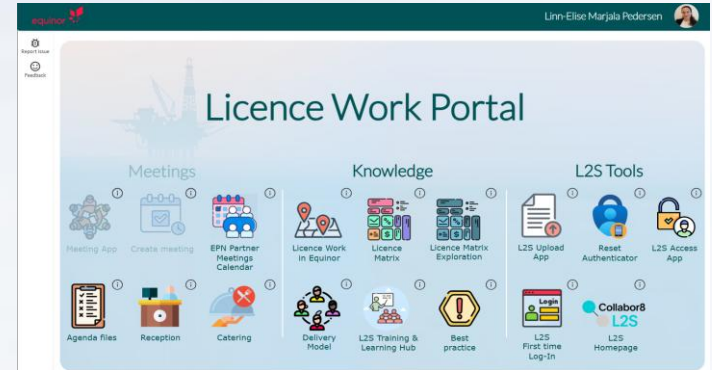




Our digital journey

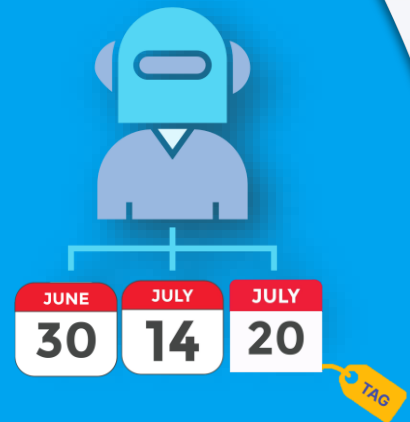

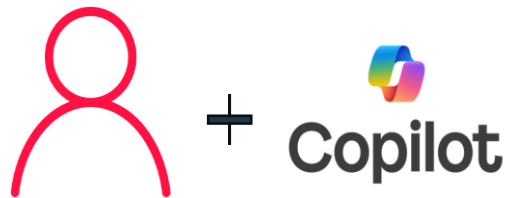

Level 1

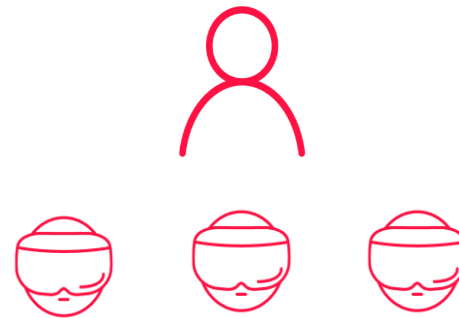
AI assistant



Employees has an AI assistant that helps them work better and faster

Level 2

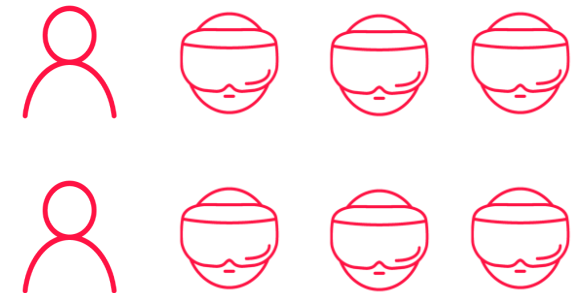
Humen-led agent teams



Agents join teams as “digital colleagues” taking on specific tasks at human directions

Level 3

Human-led, agent-operated



Humans set directions and agents run entire business processes and workflows, checking in as needed



Inspiring the future – what becomes possible next

Possibilities today:

- Use of Copilot to give summary from AC/TC/RC to prepare MC rep
- Copilot Agent that can answer questions related to JOA

Future possibilities:

- Enable easier access to information on L2S through a Copilot agent that also guides and performs correct document uploads.
- Over time, a Copilot agent could manage the meeting process in collaboration with the committee chair.
